## Note from the pastor

"The most extraordinary birth announcement ever recorded appears in Luke 2:8-14.

It was given to shepherds (Luke 2:8), which is fitting when we remember that the child born that night is both the Lamb of God (John 1:29) and the Good Shepherd (John 10:1-28). He would be found lying in a manger—an unusual place for a baby, but not uncommon for a lamb (Luke 2:12). Bethlehem's flocks often supplied the lambs used for sacrifice at the Jerusalem temple, and Jesus came to offer Himself as the final, perfect sacrifice for humanity's sins.

Angels delivered and rejoiced over this announcement (Luke 2:9, 13-14). Heaven's messengers appeared with God's radiant glory surrounding them, breaking into the darkness with divine splendor. A vast host of angels joined together, praising God for His glory and proclaiming the good news. Jesus Himself is the very radiance of God in human form (John 1:14).

This message was meant for everyone. It was universal—"good news of great joy...for all the people"—yet also deeply personal: "a Savior has been born for you, who is Christ the Lord" (Luke 2:10-11).

He is the Savior. He is the Christ.  
He is the Lord. Receive Him, and follow Him this Christmas.
